

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-07

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES FOR A BULK WATER SERVICE PERMIT.

WHEREAS, Garibaldi Municipal Code allows for the sale of bulk water through GMC 13.05.050(B); and

WHEREAS, GMC 13.05.050(B) states that organizations, municipalities and/or individuals may purchase water via a fire hydrant by acquiring a permit from the public works department and paying the fees set forth by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City currently does not have a rate set for a bulk service permit or unsupervised bulk water use deposit; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director determined that approximately one hour of staff time ("Public Works Employees" as set by Res. 2007-03) would be associated with the supervision of the bulk service; and

WHEREAS, GMC 13.05.050(B) also allows for a deposit to be assessed for unsupervised bulk water use; NOW THEREFORE


THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The fee for acquiring a Bulk Water Service Permit is \$29 or the current rate for one hour of "Public Works Employee" time as set by the most current staff fees reimbursement resolution.

Section 2. The deposit for an unsupervised bulk water service permit is \$250.

Section 3. The Bulk Water Service Permit fees and unreturned deposits will be accounted for as Connection Fees (430.037) within the Water Fund.
