

**RESOLUTION NO. 2011-13**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI DECLARING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S 1991 CHEVROLET PICK-UP TRUCK, ALSO KNOW AS 31-91, SURPLUS PROPERTY, PROVIDING FOR EXEMPTION FROM COMPETITIVE BID, AND APPROVING DISPOSAL BY LIQUIDATION SALE OR OTHER APPROPRIATE DISPOSAL METHOD**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Garibaldi owns personal property that is no longer needed for a public purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the value and nature of the vehicle to be sold or disposed of makes it probable that the cost of conducting a sale by competitive bid will be such that a liquidation sale, trade, or auction will result in substantially greater net benefit to the City of Garibaldi; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is the Local Contract Review Board for the City of Garibaldi; and

**WHEREAS**, Garibaldi Municipal Code Chapter 3.10 provides for public contract procedures including procedures for disposal of personal property; NOW THEREFORE

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI, ACTING AS LOCAL CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Surplus Property Description.**

The property described as a 1991 Chevrolet Pick-Up Truck, formally known as the Fire Department Vehicle 31-91 is declared surplus.

**Section 2. Approval of exemption from competitive bid requirements.**

Based on the recitals of this resolution, which are incorporated by reference as findings herein, the disposal of property described in Section 1 is exempt from competitive bid under Garibaldi Municipal Code Chapter 3.10.090(V) and shall be disposed of by public auction or sale, as required or appropriate under those procedures.

**Section 3. Sale or disposal.**


City staff is authorized to dispose of by auction, sale or trade the surplus property described in Section 1 in a manner most likely to result in the greatest net revenue and greatest public benefit to the City of Garibaldi.


**Section 4. Effective date.**
