

RESOLUTION 2011-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI ACTING AS LOCAL CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD ADOPTING FINDINGS ON COMPETITIVE BIDS RECEIVED FOR THE HIGHWAY 101 (GARIBALDI AVE.) 12TH STREET TO 10TH STREET SIDEWALK AND BICYCLE LANE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND REJECTING ALL BIDS

WHEREAS, the City of Garibaldi advertised for bids on the Oregon Coast Highway 101 (Garibaldi Ave.) Sidewalk and Bicycle Lane Improvements 12th To 10th Street (PROJECT) and received two responsive bids by the extended closing date of August 31st, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the city budget approved for the Project in FY 2011-2012 was in the amount of no more than \$144,000; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid received exceeds the engineer's estimate and the available budget; and

WHEREAS, negotiating with the lowest bidder to perform value engineering is not an approach that appears likely to assist the City in meeting true costs for this Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council finds that the facts as stated in the recitals to this Resolution are true and that based thereon:

A. All bids exceed the engineer's estimate and the available budget.


B. Funds available from state grants will likely be extended so that the Project may still be accomplished at a later date.

C. Rejecting all bids and delaying the Project will allow time to re-evaluate the Project budget and engineer's estimate, all in the public interest.

Section 2. The Council therefore directs that all bids related to the Project be rejected and no award made. Notice to bidders shall be provided accordingly.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective as of the date of its adoption by the City Council.
