RESOLUTION NO. 2020-04

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF A TEMPORARY STATE OF EMERGENCY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2020, the Governor of the State of Oregon issued Executive Order 20-03 declaring a statewide State of Emergency under ORS 401.025(1) due to the serious public health and safety threat posed by the spread of the COVID-19 virus within our state; and

WHEREAS, the City of Garibaldi (“the City”) has enacted local ordinance, #330, which pertains to the declaration and administration of a City-wide State of Emergency within City boundaries; and

WHEREAS, ORS Chapter 401.309 and Chapter VIII Section 32 of the City Charter City grant the City additional authority to declare a State of Emergency within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Garibaldi deemed it necessary to extend a temporary state of emergency on the 20th of April 2020, for a period of two weeks,

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT:

Section 1. The City Council hereby extends the declaration of a temporary state of emergency as established by Ordinance #330 on March 18, 2020

Section 2. This resolution is and shall be effective after its passage by the City Council until at least May 28th, 2020, but may be extended as necessary.
