

RESOLUTION 2006-17

A RESOLUTION MAKING A SPECIFIC EXEMPTION OF THE GARIBALDI PUBLIC CONTRACTING ORDINANCE ON BEHALF OF THE GARIBALDI CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, Garibaldi's Public Contracting Ordinance No. 281 allows for provisions for exemptions for awarding contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Garibaldi City Council serves as the Garibaldi Contract Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the initial budget for the Urban Renewal Agency had a line item of \$2,000 for a legal description; and

WHEREAS, staff solicited bids from five separate surveyors over the course of three months to assist the City in developing a legal description for the Garibaldi Urban Renewal Agency and that said legal description needed to be adopted at the City Council's August 21st meeting pursuant to goals set forth by the Council and City Improvement Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, by July 21st only one surveyor and one title company representative submitted proposals and that both proposals were for more than \$5,000; and


WHEREAS, the Public Contracting Ordinances states that a Specific Exemption may be made by the Contract Review Board for service contracts more than \$5,000 and less than \$150,000 and that such an exemption shall be made by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that having a legal description ready for adoption at the August 21st Council meeting would benefit the public good; NOW, THEREFORE

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Ord. 281 (Section 10), the Garibaldi Contract Review Board does award a personal services contract to JEL Property Research and Consultation for an amount not to exceed \$5,325.00 and that the deliverable product (legal description) shall be available to the City Council by August 21, 2006.
