

**RESOLUTION NO. 2008-25**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN EXEMPTION FROM COMPETITIVE BID FOR REPAIRS TO PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI FIRE DEPARTMENT DESCRIBED AS A 1988 GMC FIRE PUMPER (ALSO KNOWN AS 31-14).**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Garibaldi owns personal property that is no longer needed for a public purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the value and nature of the vehicle to be sold or disposed of makes it necessary to repair the vehicle and prepare it for sale, trade or auction as surplus property in a manner that will maximize the net benefit to the City of Garibaldi; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is the Local Contract Review Board for the City of Garibaldi; and

**WHEREAS**, Garibaldi Municipal Code Chapter 3.10 provides for public contract procedures including exemptions from competitive bid procedures; NOW THEREFORE

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI, ACTING AS LOCAL CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Exemptions to competitive bidding procedures.**

Garibaldi Municipal Code (GMC) Chapter 3.10 Public Contracts provides for Specific Exemptions from competitive bidding and finds the awarding of such contracts without competitive bidding is unlikely to encourage favoritism or substantially diminish competition for public contracts, and the awarding of such contracts will result in substantial costs savings to the city.

**Section 2. Approval of specific exemption for equipment repair.**

The repairs to personal property described as a 1988 GMC Fire Pumper are exempt from competitive bid under GMC 3.10.090(C) based on the recitals to this resolution, which are incorporated herein by reference, and the following findings of fact:


- A. The service and/or parts required are unknown and the cost of repairs could not reasonably be determined without conducting some of the repairs; and
- B. Competitive bids are not practical under the circumstances because repairs are conducted in the manner of personal service contracts, although not specifically identified as such in the city's public contract procedures; and
- C. The value of repairs is anticipated to be under \$19,000, with \$6,000 for labor and \$13,000 for parts. The estimated cost of repairs is such that it will not diminish competition to exempt the repairs from competitive bid.


**Section 3. Effective date.**
